<b>2011</b>	<b>DEEN VAT Botrytis Sémillon de Bortoli</b> <i>A medley of citrus, nectarine and quince fruit, nuances of sweet vanillin oak with just the right level of sweetness and refreshing acidity make for an elegant, substantial yet harmonious wine.</i>	£4.50	£22.00
<b>2011</b>	<b>Chateau Monteils Cru Bourgeois Sauternes</b> <i>Top quality Sauternes from this young winemaker and unusually good at this price level. Perhaps a little lighter in colour and weight than previous vintages but still amply rich and sweet with a creamy, waxy texture and a cut of acidity that keeps the whole beautifully streamlined.</i>	£6.00	£28.00

<b>NV</b>	<b>Valdespino Innocente Fino Sherry, Spain</b> <i>Straw-yellow coloured. The aromas are delicate and complex, with notes of almonds. This is deliciously full and has the classical richness of fruit that one expects to find in the best Pouilly Fuissés. The benefit of subtle oak maturation provides depth and complexity on the finish.</i>		£35.00
<b>2009</b>	<b>Puligny Montrachet 'les Enseignieres', Chavy-Chouet</b> <i>Lovely depth and purity with lively fruit. It's fresh but intense: a lovely wine.</i>		£60.00
<b>2011</b>	<b>Condrieu, Domaine Chirat</b> <i>Long, rich and silky on the palate. Lovely straw yellow to golden colour.</i>		£45.00
